

The following provides all the information necessary to safely operate the previously listed products of Feniex Industries, Inc. Please read this manual thoroughly before installing or operating your new product in order to prevent any damage or injury. Failure to follow the listed instructions in this manual may result in damage to your products or personal injury.

- Proper installation of this product requires good knowledge of automotive systems, electronics and procedures.
- Please guarantee all vital components of the vehicle are not in danger of being damaged by drilling holes necessary for installation. Check all sides of the mounting surface before drilling any holes into the vehicle.
- Do not install this product in any way that interferes with the deployment of the air bag. Doing so may damage the effectiveness of the air bag and can lead to serious personal and vehicle injury. The installer will assume full responsibility of proper installation of the new unit.
- Please clean the mounting surface before installation of the unit when using tape, brackets, magnet, Velcro or suction cups.
- The product's ground wire must be connected directly to the Negative (-) battery post for effective use of the unit. Please follow all wiring guidelines provided to guarantee long lifespan and productivity. Failing to follow these instructions may result in damage to the product.

Warranty

Feniex Industries, Inc. warrants to the original purchaser that the product shall be free from defects in material and workmanship for 5 years from the date of purchase for all LED products. Feniex Industries warranties speakers, sirens, flashers, and controllers for 2 years.





WIRING DIAGRAM





<u>Step 1</u>: In order to activate the unit, extend the red, 12V+ wire to the 12V+ post of the vehicle's battery. Extend the black, 12V-wire to the ground post of the vehicle's battery.

Step 2: To turn the unit on, connect the Brown wire to a 12V+ power source or switch.

Step 3: Momentarily connect the white wire to a 12V- source to change flash patterns.

<u>Step 4</u>: With the brown wire still connected to 12V+, connect the green wire to the brown wire. This should engage the dimming function on, turning all LEDs on to 5% of the original brightness.

<u>Step 5</u>: To engage turn signal/steady on, connect the grey wire to 12V+. This function should engage all LEDs steady on at 50% of brightness.

<u>Step 6</u>: To engage tail light/steady on, connect the blue wire to the 12V+. All LEDs will turn steady on at 5% of the original brightness.


Step 7: To engage Brake Mode/Steady on, connect the yellow wire to 12V+. This function will turn all LEDs steady on at 50% brightness. Note on this function the unit will flash twice and then engage into steady on mode.

Optional Step: To Alternate Light Heads

For the light head to alternate, one light head must be set as master and the other as slave on the mode wire interded for use. To do so, hold the white (flash pattern changer) wire to ground for 3 seconds. If all LEDs turn on this indicates master mode. If half the LEDs activate this indicates slave mode. Set one unit as master and the other as slave.






- 2.) Place against the intended mounting surface and mark the holes for drilling.
- 3.) Mark the areas where the mounting holes will be drilled. If the mounting surface is part of the vehicle, make sure no vital components could be damaged by the drilling process. There is an installation template available at feniex.com.
- 4.) Drill the mounting holes in the marked surface. If wires need to pass through the vehicle, drill a 0.5" diameter hole for wire passage. Make sure to deburr holes thoroughly.
- 5.) Pass the wires through the 0.5" diameter hole and secure the Surface Mount with bezel and gasket to the mounting surface using the factory provided screws (ensure no vital components are damaged when drilling holes for the surface mount).

Mounting Option 2: No Bezel

- 1.) Place the large bolt (part #1) in the rear of the control, as shown in the diagram.
- 2.) Secure the bolt by placing the bracket (part #2) over the bolt so the bracket is flush with the gasket.
- 3.) Secure the bracket and bolt to the rear of the gasket with the two factory provided screws (part #3).
- 4.) Mark the areas where the mounting holes will be drilled. If the mounting surface is part of the vehicle, make sure no vital components could be damaged by the drilling process.
- 5.) Drill two mounting holes on the mounting surface, making sure no vital components of the surface are damaged.
- 6.) Using customer provided screws, secure the Wide Lux to the mounting surface.
